### The Formula for Revival

- *The most important factor in this equation in how much energy is produced is the speed of light since it is a huge number and it is squared.*
- *The mass used in this reaction is not unimportant but in itself it is not the number that reflects the great release of power.*
- *What is the spiritual application?*

1 John 1:5 (NKJV)

<sup>5</sup>This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all.

John 8:12 (NKJV)

<sup>12</sup>Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life."

- *Jesus Christ is the light.*
- *We are like the mass or earthly substance.*
- *We don't contribute a huge part in this powerful reaction but without the mass there would be no reaction and release of power.*
- *Jesus Christ is the Light of the World and thus He is the source of all power.*
- $E = mc^2$
- *Even though the speed of light is the defining factor for the exponential power to be released, mass must be present for the reaction to take place.*

John 9:5 (NKJV)

<sup>5</sup>As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.

- *Jesus Christ is now on the right hand of the Father and we are now on the earth as His ambassadors.*

Matthew 5:14 (NKJV)

<sup>14</sup>"You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden.

- *Every born again Christian has the light of Jesus Christ in their spirit and we are not to hide that light but learn to let it shine.*

Colossians 1:27 (NKJV)

<sup>27</sup>To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.

- *Christ in each born again believer is where the power of God resides.*

Ephesians 5:8 (NKJV)

<sup>8</sup>For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light

- *Our lives are to reflect the reality that we are children of light.*
- *What happens if we fully surrender our lives to Jesus Christ?*
- $E = mc^2$
- *Tremendous power is released and the power of the Holy Spirit is manifest.*
- *REVIVAL will break out all around us!*

John 14:12-15 (NKJV)

<sup>12</sup>"Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father.

- *If we put our full trust in Christ then He will do the greater works through us.*

<sup>13</sup>And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

<sup>14</sup>If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.

- *The purpose of God manifesting His power is to glorify Himself and draw people to His son Jesus Christ.*

<sup>15</sup>“If you love Me, keep My commandments.

- *Obedience is the key for us to see God’s power and will fulfilled in us and through us.*
- *Un-confessed and un-dealt with sin will hinder us from walking with Christ*
- *Un-confessed sin is like darkness and if there is darkness in our souls then the light of Christ cannot be released.*

Ephesians 1:22–23 (NKJV)

<sup>22</sup>And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the church,

<sup>23</sup>which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.

- *Jesus Christ is the Head but the Church is His Body and He works through His Body.*

Ephesians 3:17–21 (NKJV)

<sup>17</sup>that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love,

- *“that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith” – It is through faith that we experience fellowship with Christ in our hearts.*

<sup>18</sup>may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height—

<sup>19</sup>to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.

- *One of our main goals in life should be to fully understand the fullness of Christ’s love for us.*
- *“to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge” - The love of Christ cannot be fully grasped by just employing our intellect but it is a spiritual revelation that we receive as we move in faith.*

<sup>20</sup>Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us,

- *When we surrender fully to God then He does things in our lives that even goes beyond our ability to ask or even imagine.*

<sup>21</sup>to Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

- *God manifesting His love and power to us does not stop in this life but for all eternity there is a continual unfolding of greater and greater revelation and experiences.*

Acts 17:6 (NKJV)

<sup>6</sup>But when they did not find them, they dragged Jason and some brethren to the rulers of the city, crying out, “These who have turned the world upside down have come here too.

- “These who have turned the world upside down have come here too.” – *This handful of disciples of Jesus simply going about sharing the Gospel and praying for the sick are seen as those that are destabilizing the great Roman Empire.*
- *The Moravian Prayer Movement*

#### Revelation 12:10–11 (NKJV)

<sup>10</sup>Then I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, “Now salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them before our God day and night, has been cast down.

<sup>11</sup>And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.

- *How do we overcome the anti-christ, the devil and all the evil and sin in this world?*
- *“By the blood of the Lamb” – we must be fully confident that once we have received Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour we now children of God.*
- *Anytime we are convicted of sin and realize that we have moved in the flesh, we must come to God and confess our sins and ask for forgiveness.*
- *“by the word of their testimony” – the second step of being an overcomer is to have a life that is pure and holy.*
- *Our testimony, the way we live, speak and even think is to be yielded to Jesus Christ.*
- *We are to live our lives so that any time we sin we immediately repent.*

#### Job 1:1 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup>There was a man in the land of Uz, whose name was Job; and that man was blameless and upright, and one who feared God and shunned evil.

- *What does it mean that Job was blameless and upright? It doesn't mean that Job never sinned but that he knew how to deal with sin. He understood the need for the sacrifice and his need to confess his sins immediately.*
- *“they did not love their lives to the death” – the third step of being an overcomer is self sacrifice. It is where we put Christ first in every area of our lives.*
- *For us to live lives that are totally surrendered to Jesus Christ and the will of God we must have clear vision and purpose.*

#### Psalms 27:4 (NKJV)

<sup>4</sup>One thing I have desired of the LORD, That will I seek: That I may dwell in the house of the LORD All the days of my life, To behold the beauty of the LORD, And to inquire in His temple.

- *“One thing I have desired of the LORD” – There was only one thing that stirred David's heart when he was focused on God.*
- *“That I may dwell in the house of the LORD All the days of my life” – David's greatest joy was to abide in the presence of the Lord.*
- *“To behold the beauty of the LORD” – To just be able to gaze and look upon the beauty and the glory of the Lord.*
- *“And to inquire in His temple” – To meditate upon God and to begin to learn to think His thoughts and see things from His perspective.*
